In July 2022, Innovate Alabama launched a supplemental grant program to provide additional resources to small businesses that have an active Phase I or Phase II Federal Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) grant.

The Innovate Alabama Supplemental Grant Program is unique because funds dispersed through this grant program are nondilutive, meaning recipients do not have to exchange shares of their company for the grant. This investment is possible because these businesses have been subject to scientific review by experts and have demonstrated to a federal agency that their technologies are viable, valuable and scalable.

In addition to helping support the state's leading entrepreneurs and innovators, dispersing these funds grows Alabama's economy by (1) stimulating research and commercialization, (2) developing exportable products and services and (3) creating and retaining high-wage jobs in skilled occupations.

USE OF FUNDS

Innovate Alabama Supplemental Grants are used to fund and advance research and commercialization efforts. The recipients will be able to use these funds to support and grow their businesses within the state, benefiting local business owners who are commercializing modern technology, as well as growing the state's regional and national economic footprint.
